The Most Important Must Know Drugs For NCLEX - NCLEX Exam ...

Nursing Considerations:-may lead to pseudomembranous colitis, pain, diarrhea, nausea, Stevens-Johnson syndrome, angioedema - may increase risks for warfarin toxicity - monitor patient for signs

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of anaphylaxis - instruct patient to notify physician for diarrhea, or blood or pus in stool - instruct patient to take medication exactly as prescribed

Pneumonia Nursing Interventions and Care Plans ...

Schedule II —drugs with high potential for abuse and requires written prescription (e.g., Ritalin, hydromorphone (Dilaudid), meperidine (Demerol), and fentanyl). Schedule III —requires new prescription after six months or five refills (e.g., codeine, testosterone, ketamine).

In addition to the Ten Rights of Medication Administration and identifying the patient using at least two unique identifiers, nurses must also insure medication safety in respect to the storage of medications, the checking for expiration dates, checking for any patient allergies, and checking for any incompatibilities.
